TFF Youth Mentoring Program

The Townsville Folk Festival Youth Music Mentoring Program (TFFYMP) is a new initiative designed to support the region's emerging young musicians.

The Townsville Folk Festival, in partnership with King Konz School of Music, will deliver the 8-week program that offers weekly mentoring sessions for eight solo or group participants, from various musical genres to develop their skills.

Beginning in April, the program culminates in a showcase performance on the Jam Tin Stage at the annual Townsville Folk Festival.

A People's Choice winner will be selected to perform again on Sunday 8 June providing a unique platform for young talent to shine.
