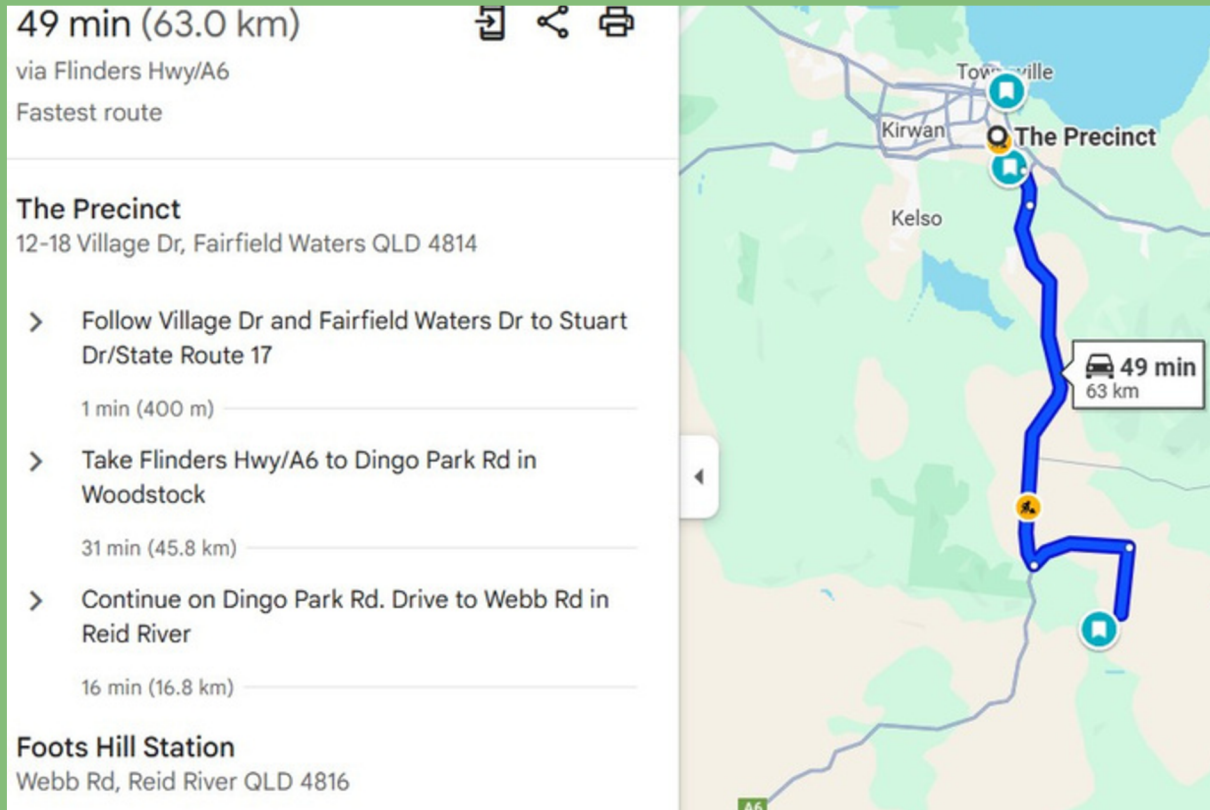

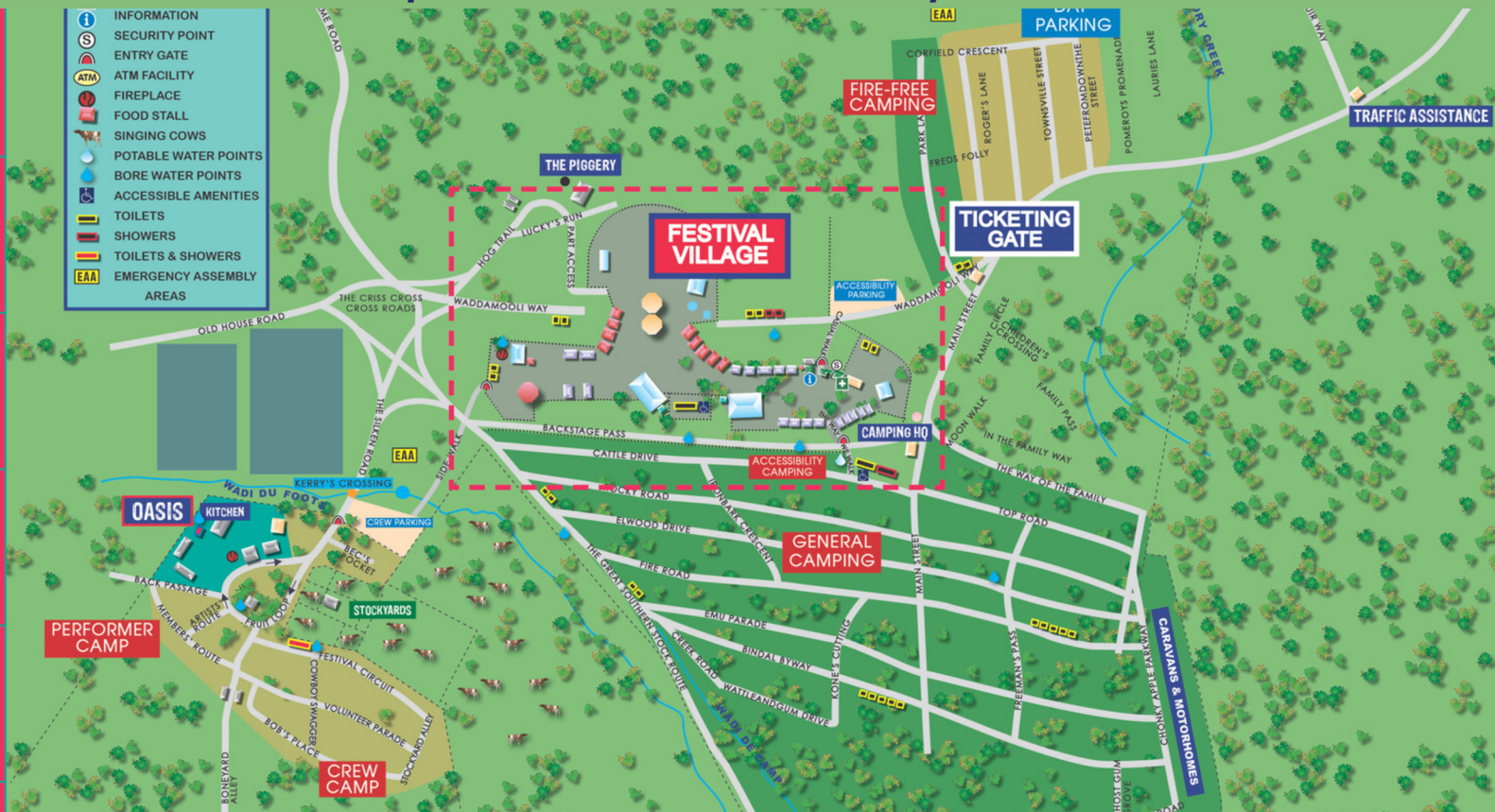

TFF FAQ's

When is the Festival?

The Townsville Folk Festival runs from Friday 6 June to Sunday 8 June.

When can I camp?

The festival gates open at 10:00 AM on Friday, June 6. Please do not arrive before this time unless you are a Volunteer or have made prior arrangements with the organisers. The festival program begins at 4:00 PM on Friday 6 June and all attendees must depart by 10:00 AM on Monday 9 June.

What is the festival theme this year?

There is no specific festival theme this year but please decorate your campsite and remember fancy dress is welcome, especially for the Festival Parade!

Is the festival wheelchair accessible? Absolutely! The festival site is wheelchair-accessible and has disability-access toilet facilities and disability parking available.

What is the festival's policy on seating?

Bring your own camp chairs or relax on the comfy hay bales provided.

Will the festival proceed in bad weather?

Yes, the festival will continue rain or shine. Please prepare for warm days, cool nights, and possible rain. Don't forget sunscreen, hats and weather-appropriate clothing.

Are program changes possible?

Yes, the organizers reserve the right to change the festival program.

Do I need to bring cash?

Yes please, most vendors prefer cash so plan ahead and bring cash!

Can I buy alcohol at the Festival?

No, the festival does not have alcohol vendors on site and is a BYO event. We do sell ice near the Merch Tent to keep your drinks cool.
