Block printing is a hands-on workshop where participants are invited to slow down and reconnect with the process of creating. Rooted in traditions of Indian block printing, the experience introduces guests to hand-carved wooden blocks, natural dyes, and mindful making.

Each person creates their own printed tote bag piece while learning about the history, craftsmanship, and beauty behind this centuries-old art form.
